

Computerized system CGA module Cafeteria

- ✓ **Control of plates served per shift:** A PC is installed at the cafeteria and a decoder is connected, so as each employee goes by to pick up its lunch, he presents the id card and the consumption is recorded.
- ✓ **Snacks served to personnel working overtime:** The work shifts are established indicating the period of time to be considered as breakfast, lunch or snacks, to identify the type of consumption.
- ✓ **Deductions on payroll to employees:** To comply with the Income Tax Law requirement, which establishes that the food would not be given for free in order to make this a deductible expense, this module transfers the minimum amount in pesos previously determined to be deducted on payroll to the employee.
- ✓ **Invoice of the Cafeteria Vendor:** Controls the total plates served by date to pay the Cafeteria Vendor.
- ✓ **Reports:** The module includes reports of each of these 4 concepts, sorted by employee and dates.
- ✓ **Technical characteristics:** Operative systems: Windows NT or higher, Data Base Microsoft SQL Client Server, programming Visual Dbase. Multi-user and multi-company unlimited.
